## CASE OF SARATA v. POLAND (Application no. 2415/21)

I, Agnieszka Kozińska-Makowska, Agent of the Government, declare that the Government of Poland offer to pay to Zbigniew Sarata, with a view to securing a friendly settlement of the above-mentioned case pending before the European Court of Human Rights, EUR 10,000 (ten thousand euros) to cover any and all pecuniary and non-pecuniary damage as well as costs and expenses, plus any tax that may be chargeable to the applicant.

This sum will be converted into Polish Zloty at the rate applicable on the date of payment, and will be payable within three months from the date of notification of the decision taken by the Court to strike the case out of its list of cases. In the event of failure to pay this sum within the said three-month period, the Government undertake to pay simple interest on it, from expiry of that period until settlement, at a rate equal to the marginal lending rate of the European Central Bank during the default period plus three percentage points. The payment will constitute the final resolution of the case.

## CASE OF SARATA v. POLAND (Application no. 2415/21)

I, Monika Małgorzata Gąsiorowska, note that the Government of Poland are prepared to pay to Zbigniew Sarata, with a view to securing a friendly settlement of the above-mentioned case pending before the European Court of Human Rights, EUR 10,000 (ten thousand euros) to cover any and all pecuniary and non-pecuniary damage as well as costs and expenses, plus any tax that may be chargeable to the applicant.

This sum will be converted into Polish Zloty at the rate applicable on the date of payment, and will be payable within three months from the date of notification of the decision taken by the Court to strike the case out of its list of cases. From the expiry of the above-mentioned three months until settlement simple interest shall be payable on the above amount at a rate equal to the marginal lending rate of the European Central Bank during the default period plus three percentage points.

Having consulted the applicant, I would inform you that he accepts the proposal and waives any further claims against Poland in respect of the facts giving rise to this application. He declares that this constitutes a final resolution of the case.
